A. FELLOWSHIP RESTORED BY JESUS CHRIST WHEN WE SIN (2:1-2)

1. Sin interrupts your fellowship with God. (2:1)

- Who are “*My little children*”?
- What does “*Advocate*” emphasize?

2. Jesus Christ provides every Christian with an ongoing Fellowship with God. (2:2)

- What does “*propitiation*” emphasize?
- To what extent did Jesus Christ’s death pay for sins?

B. FELLOWSHIP DEMONSTRATED WHEN WE “KEEP” HIS WORD (2:3-6)

1. Keeping God’s Word demonstrates your fellowship with God. (2:3)

- To what does “*know Him*” refer?

2. Keeping God’s Word demonstrates maturity in your life. (2:4-5)

- Are we TALKERS or are we KEEPERS?

3. Your words and your life SHOULD reflect a walk with Jesus Christ the Righteous. (2:6)

- How do “ABIDE” and “WALK” differ?
- What are the emphasis in this passage?
