2. Why does Peter use numerous references to the Old Testament when preaching? (compare Romans 15:4; 2 Timothy 3:16)
3. How does Deuteronomy 18:15-18 aid our understanding of Peter's message?
4. How many titles/names can you identify in the text that Peter attributes to Jesus?

Applying the Scripture

Peter's Sermon

-linked Jesus to Scripture.

-proclaimed Jesus to be the way of everlasting life.

-declared that God the Father raised Jesus from the dead.

-revealed Jesus as the seed through which the entire earth would be blessed.
